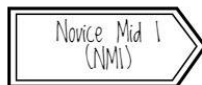
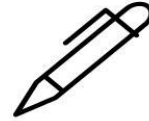

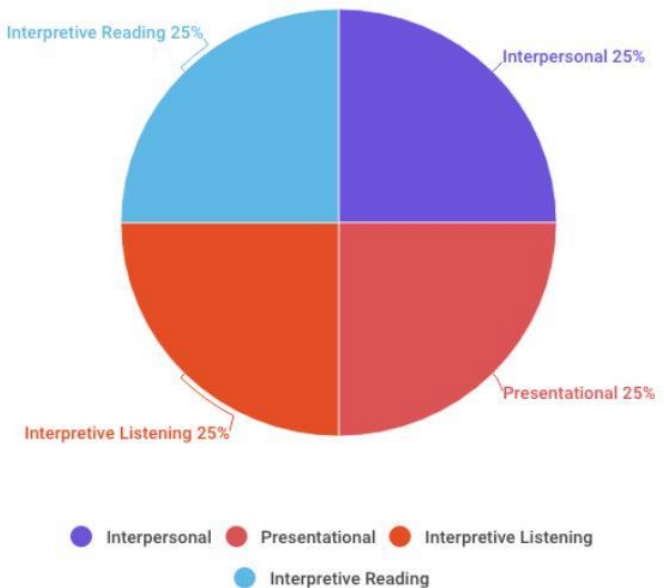

Category of Grades

Types of Assessments

Major Assessment: 30 points
Minor Assessment: 20 points
Homework: 10 points



Wait...what?

Every assignment you receive will be under a certain category: interpretive reading, interpretive listening, interpersonal, or presentational. Every quarter, you will get a grade for each category.

Example:

Interpretive reading: 96%
Interpretive listening: 93%
Presentational: 90%
Interpersonal: 91%

So your final quarter grade: 92.5%

By the end of the year, you can....

...communicate and exchange information about familiar topics using phrases and simple sentences, sometimes supported by memorized language. You can usually handle short social interaction in everyday situations by asking and answering simple questions.

...understand familiar words, phrases, and sentences within short and simple texts related to everyday life. You can sometimes understand the main idea of what you have read.

...often understand words, phrases, and simple sentences related to everyday life. You can recognize pieces of information and sometimes understand the main topic of what is being said.

...pretty cool, huh?



...write short messages and notes on familiar topics related to everyday life.
